

PENNINE SAILING CLUB

GENERAL REGULATIONS 2007

1. Sailing will not take place in winds in excess of 25 knots.
2. Boats must not sail in the prohibited areas defined on the course plinth. (Any breach of this regulation must be reported to a member of the Management Committee and the appropriate form completed.)
3. Personal buoyancy must be worn at all times when on the water.
4. Children under the age of 14 years must be supervised by their parent/guardian *ad litem*. They are not allowed in the storage containers at any time.
5. A support boat must be equipped and manned before any sailing can take place. Buddy sailing is not permitted.
6. Joy-riding is not permitted in the powerboats.
7. When driving the powerboats, kill cords must be worn at all times.
8. The seaworthiness of a craft is the owner's/helmsman's responsibility.
9. Club craft must be checked for seaworthiness before use by the hirer/user. Any defects and/or breakages during use should be repaired by the user or reported to a Management Committee member.
10. Cars must be removed from the dinghy park to the designated car park.
11. Personal property including valuables should not be left in the clubhouse or changing rooms. The club cannot be held liable for the loss of personal property left on their premises.
12. Boats, trailers and trollies left in the dinghy park are left at the owner's risk. The club has done its best to provide secure tie-down points but cannot be held responsible for any failure of these.
13. Boats must be stored in their allocated berth but the Committee reserves the right to relocate them for operational reasons.
14. Smoking is not permitted in clubhouse, the containers or in the vicinity of the fuel stores.
15. Refuelling of safety boats may only be carried out in the vicinity of the fuel stores. Spillages of fuel must be mopped up using the pads provided in the store.
